- A proposal from Ettrick Legion Post for final approval? Review of the agreement for Legion and Youth group. Proposal was read with minor updates to language to make more precise in meaning. Motion to approve the agreement between Ettrick Legion Post, EYSC and GET Youth Sports club for the High School Legion baseball and softball program by Meghan, second by Amanda. - The Municipality Survey is out and circulating; 83 people completed as of 11/7/24: Plan is (survey still ongoing) keep reviewing.

Swim Team Registration Cost for 2025

- Need to set Registration Cost for 2025
 - Info from Sept/Oct. Meetings:
 - 2024 charged for 32 hrs of Swim Team practices at \$14/hr (\$448.00 total; equated to \$9.53 per swimmer (47 Swim Team Members)
 - 2025 Village is looking to charge \$60 per hour for pool use potentially (they are looking for feedback); if we had 47 Swim Team members next year, and used the pool for say 40 hours (no early season this year) = \$2,400 / 47 = approx. \$51 per swimmer (current Swim Team Registration is \$35 per participant
 - Agreed to go with \$40/hr in 2025, \$50/hr in 2026, \$60/hr in 2027
 - Registration to be opened here soon. Table of price increase until December meeting.

o Tremp Main Improvements Updates:

- Bathrooms, Dirt moving/reseeding, internet/cameras
- Toilets have been installed but missing seats. Partitions are in bathroom, but not installed yet. Dirt moved and reseeding will be done again in spring. City added dirt in behind the bleachers and leveled off. Some wires have been run and still need to complete the camera installations to run wires through the concessions.
